About our Programme

Research shows that women face particular issues when considering moving into leadership roles. This course helps women manage the challenges of maintaining a work / life balance and gain the confidence to apply and succeed in leadership roles in school.

Objectives

-  To support delegates in reviewing and evaluating own strengths and areas for development
-  To support delegates in developing a direction for their future career
-  To facilitate discussion of different styles and effectiveness of approaches to leadership
-  To encourage delegates into different school contexts to inform their views of current practice and what leadership looks like
-  To consider practical approaches to developing and consolidating skills for future career developments
-  To support delegates in next step promotions



Coaching

As part of the programme an external professional coach will provide 2 coaching sessions for delegates supported by the use of the EQ-i assessment report (emotional intelligence)

Female leaders who have the skills and experience to move from middle leadership to assistant headteacher level as well as deputy headship, but are yet to take that step.
